## Winter & Snow Policy

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the Public Parking during conditions which may cause the Town of West New York roads to become hazardous to automobile and pedestrian travel and to ensure adequate space and access to parking lots and meter streets.

### **Definition:**

**Meters:** A device that is placed in public streets, lots, garage that registers the amount of time purchased for the parking of a motor vehicle, at the expiration of which the driver is liable for a fine.

**Parking Lots:** Parking facilities include indoor and outdoor private property; open to the public with multiple meters that are laid out for such use as to pay for parking.

### **Enforcement Area:**

The policy requires that all vehicle owners and holders to understand the Enforcement Area is not limited to the following areas: All West New York parking lots (51<sup>st</sup>, 54<sup>th</sup>, 55<sup>th</sup>, 58<sup>th</sup>, 59<sup>th</sup>, 62<sup>nd</sup>, 63<sup>rd</sup>, 66<sup>th</sup>, 67<sup>th</sup>, Triangle), all main Avenues (Bergenline, Park Ave, Kennedy Blvd, Boulevard East) and all side meter Streets.

Permit parking will be enforced unless told otherwise by the Parking Authority after any snow, or winter weather. It is the responsibility of the resident to clean off their vehicle and ensure their parking permit is visible. Parking Enforcement Officers are NOT authorized to remove snow from any vehicle. If the permit is not visible, the vehicle will be ticketed for permit Parking Violation.

City Ordinances restricts any vehicle from remaining in the same space on any street for a period exceeding 48 hours. This violation will be strictly enforced on all streets, parking lots, 48 hours after the snow emergency has been lifted. Failure to comply will result in the ticketing and potential towing of the vehicle.
